Meeting Minutes
March 5, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 5:05 PM. Pickett arrived several minutes late.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the February 8, 2020 meeting were approved. Motion to approve minutes made by Ed and, 2nd by David.

Treasurer's Report: Ed provide the financial statements for the month of February and YTD. Jay made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, 2nd by Keith, all in favor. Motion approved. There was some discussion on what to charge for the Member/Guest later this year. Target is 60 teams with 120 players. Pricing TBD. PAGC will contribute \$1000.00 dollars into the prize pool.

Membership Report: John F. sent update earlier today. Several new members – 4 in February and 4 in March have joined club. As of today, 226 members of the PAGC.

Tournament Report: Chuck P. provided the tournament update. In response to email sent by A. Fink, the club adopted a rule for all NCGA tournaments to be played from the white-tees that is consistent with NCGA championship events. Trevor suggested that we track results from the white tees during NCGA Zone events. The Member/Guest will be held on 10/25/2020 at 8 AM, a shotgun start, \$100.00per player. Optional Skins-Game will begin with Poppy Ridge outing, system set-up in Member Planet. (Member Planet requires an update, John F. will follow up).

Other Business:

- Female participants in events will play from white-tees with female handicap.
- This week's NCGA Qualifier will be 2 flights and will use the 85%/handicap rule.
- Seton Scramble on May 11, 2020; \$350.00 per player.
- Request to determine when clubs aerate greens and general course conditions prior to our events. To be continued.
