

PAGC Annual Meeting - Virtual - COVID-19 Restrictions
6/13/2020

A quorum was present, 27 members/23 required

The meeting was called to order by Trevor Heathorn, President at 11:05 AM.

Minutes of the May 2019 meeting were read.

Treasurer's Report: Ed Barkley presented the report with a forecasted balance of \$3700.00. So far this year the few tournaments that we have held have averaged 46 players vs. 37 the same period last year. Our current bank balance is \$11,425 dollars.

Membership Report: Total members to date, 230.

Communication Report: Sarang is working with Baylands to update the Pro-shop flyer, Pro-shop prizes, social media and website announcements once tournaments are up and running again.

Handicap Report: No golf, no issues. John Harris has assisted several members with score corrections, etc.

Tournament Report: Chuck Pickett congratulated Ken Arends as the 2019 Player of the Year.

5 tournaments have been cancelled so far due to Covid-19. Crazy Horse will host our 'reopening' tournament on June 20, limited to 24 players and certain restrictions.

The July 25th tournament at Blackhorse is also confirmed. The stroke-play championship scheduled for July 11/12 is not yet confirmed. We may register the field and refund if necessary. Chuck and the Board gave a shout-it to the Tournament Directors. They work hard to make the events a success.

New Business: Trevor announced that if the July 11/12 tournament is on, it will be with restrictions e.g., social distancing, one person keeping the scorecards, etc.

John Osness announced that the Thursday Match Play Series may begin in July with new teams - La Positas and Palo Alto Hills thanks to Ed W.'s efforts.

Thanks to James Kaku, too, for his efforts.

No other business brought forth by the Board or members.
